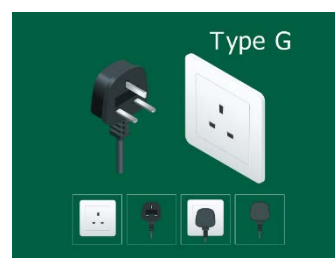
Weather

October is one of the most pleasant times to visit Hong Kong, with warm temperatures, lower humidity and plenty of sunshine. Average temperatures typically range from **around 23°C to 29°C**. Visitors are advised to bring light clothing, as well as a light jacket for cooler evenings or air-conditioned indoor venues.

Voltage

Hong Kong uses a **220V, 50Hz** electricity supply and **Type G three-pin plugs**. Visitors may need a plug adapter for their electronic devices.



Currency & Payment

The local currency is the **Hong Kong Dollar (HKD)**. **Cash, credit cards** and **debit cards** are widely accepted throughout Hong Kong.

Visitors may also use an **Octopus Card** for convenient payment on public transport and at many shops, restaurants and convenience stores. It can be purchased in MTR stations and most convenience stores, and can also be added to Apple Wallet and Google Wallet on compatible devices.

Getting to and from Hong Kong Airport

Hong Kong International Airport is well connected to the city by **Airport Express**, **airport buses** and **taxis**.

Transportation

Hong Kong has an efficient and extensive public transport network, making it easy to travel around the city.

MTR (Mass Transit Railway)

The [MTR](#) is the fastest and most convenient way to get around Hong Kong. Trains are frequent, clean and easy to navigate. Contactless credit and debit card payments are accepted, while an Octopus Card offers a discounted fares.

Bus

Double-decker bus network covers almost every part of the city, including areas not directly served by the MTR. Simply tap your Octopus card, credit card, mobile wallet or cash when boarding. Please note that no change is given when pay with cash.

Minibus

Red minibuses mostly just accept coins and cash, while green minibuses accept Octopus Card as well. They travel to everywhere but do not have stops announcement, passengers are advised to pay attention to the route.

Taxi

Most taxi accept cash, while some may also accept Octopus Card and other electronic payments. Fares are metered, with surcharges applicable for tunnels and luggage. There are 3 types of taxis running around different territories in Hong Kong:

- Red Taxi: Kowloon and Hong Kong Island
- Green Taxi: New Territories
- Blue Taxi: Islands

Tram (Hong Kong Island only)

Known locally as “Ding Ding”, Hong Kong’s iconic double-decker tram operates along the northern corridor of Hong Kong Island. For details, please refer to the tram’s [website](#).

Ferry

The ferry services offer a scenic way to travel across Victoria Harbour. Frequent routes connect Tsim Sha Tsui with Central and Wan Chai, providing an affordable alternative way for travelling between Kowloon and Hong Kong Island. For details, please refer to the Star Ferry’s [website](#).

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited in indoor public places, on public transport and in designated no-smoking areas throughout Hong Kong.

Please note that the **import of e-cigarettes, vapes and other alternative smoking products is prohibited**, and possession of these products in public places is illegal under Hong Kong law.

Pass Collection

Registration & enquiry counters will be set up at two main venues of the Expo and the official hotel. Pass holders are reminded to **bring the confirmation email** and **collect the printed badge** at the registration & enquiry counter:

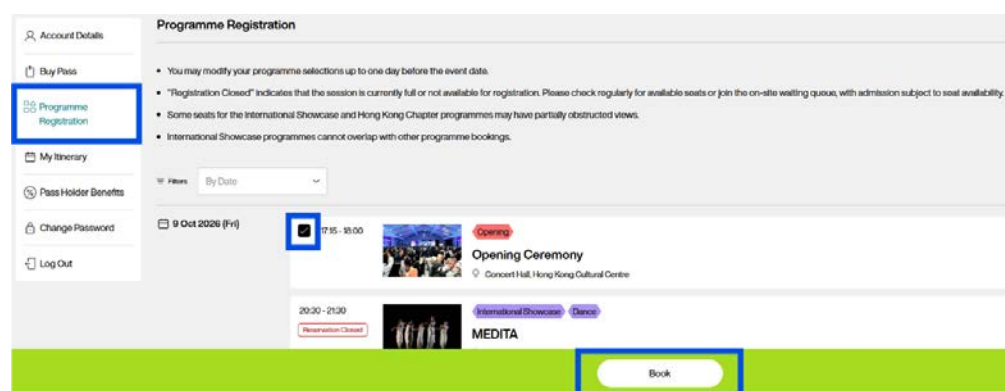
Participants are advised to arrive early to allow sufficient time for registration and to enjoy a smooth and pleasant Expo experience.

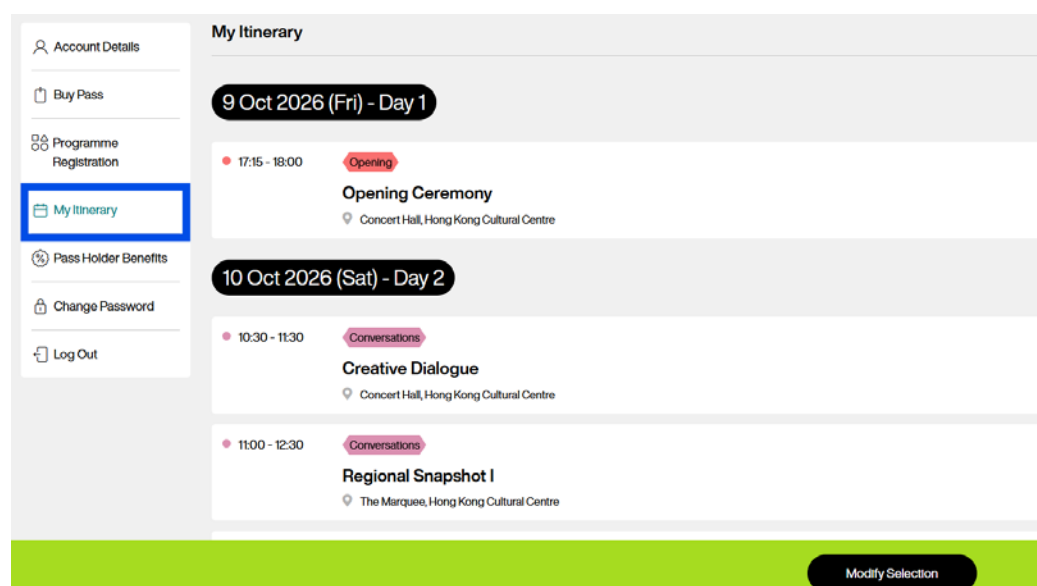
Programme Registration & Modify Reservation

Arrival and Seat arrangement

All performances offer free seating, on a first-come, first-served basis. Registered participants are required to arrive and be seated 15 minutes before the scheduled programme start time. Seats will be held until the scheduled start time; any unoccupied seats at that time will be released to standby attendees.

Standby queue

No online waitlist will be available for each programme. An onsite standby queue will be arranged at each programme venue. **Eligible pass holders who are unable to secure a booking online but wish to attend may join the standby queue at the venue. Admission will be subject to seat availability.**
